

Illness Policy

It is in highest interest of your child and the other children at Iqra Islamic School to keep your child at home when he/she is ill.

After a fever, your child's temperature must be normal Celsius from hours before returning the child to school.

Any child with a loose bowel movement may not return to the school until he/she has had a normal stool or no stool for 24 hours. This usually means an absence of 24 hours.

Any child with discharging eyes may not come to school until the eyes have been free of discharge for 24 hours.

Any child, who has vomited, may not come to school until he/she has not vomited for 24 hours and taking and retaining a regular diet.

If your child becomes ill at school, and you are called, you are requested to please pick up your child promptly. You will not be called unless your child needs to be at home.
